

Spanish Basic Language Sequence

Note to advisors: Students with 2 or more years of high school Spanish who register in SPAN 101 **will be dropped** from the course.

<p>SPAN 101 Introduction to the Spanish language, including reading, writing, and conversational skills for basic communication; cultural and linguistic information about the Spanish-speaking world. Intended for students with fewer than 2 years of high school Spanish. (3 hrs a week; 3 credits)</p>	<p>SPAN 102 Elementary Spanish II. Continuing introduction to the Spanish language, including reading, writing, and conversational skills for basic communication; cultural and linguistic information about the Spanish-speaking world. Prerequisite: Spanish 101 or equivalent. (3 hrs a week; 3 credits)</p>	<p>SPAN 201 Intermediate Spanish I. Hybrid course (2 hours in class + 1 hour online). Development of proficiency in speaking, reading, writing and understanding Spanish with cultural and linguistic information. Prerequisite: Spanish 102 or equivalent. (2 hrs a week; 3 credits)</p>	<p>SPAN 202 Intermediate Spanish II. Emphasis on communication and cultural information about the Spanish-speaking world. Prerequisite: Spanish 201 or equivalent. (3 hrs a week; 3 credits)</p>
<p>SPAN 121 Accelerated Elementary Spanish. Hybrid course (2 hours in class + 1 hour online). Begins with a review of high school Spanish and continues with the study of the language including reading, writing, and conversational skills for basic communication; cultural and linguistic information about the Spanish-speaking world. Intended for students with 2 or more years of high school Spanish. (2 hrs a week; 3 credits)</p>			
<p>SPAN 111 Intensive Spanish I. Spanish 101 and 102 in one semester. To develop proficiency in Spanish, with cultural information about the Spanish-speaking world. No prerequisite. (6 hours a week; 6 credits)</p>		<p>SPAN 211 Intensive Spanish II. Spanish 201 and 202 in one semester. To continue to develop proficiency in Spanish, with cultural information about the Spanish-speaking world. Prerequisite: Span 111 (no exceptions). (6 hrs a week; 6 credits)</p>
